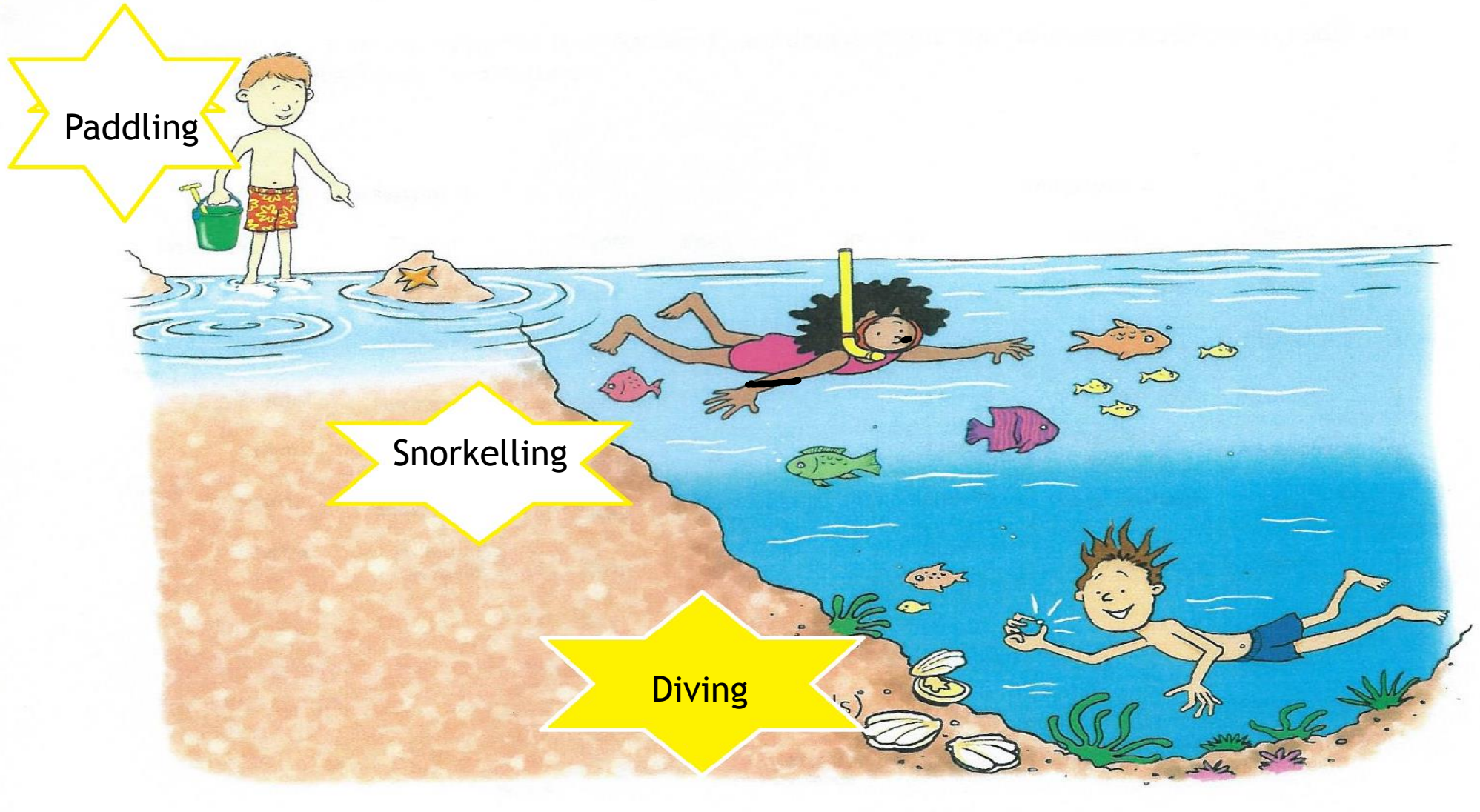
# The journey so far....

# What will the new curriculum mean to my child?

- ▶ Personalised approach
- ▶ Through the same subjects
- ▶ Mastery curriculum through the depth of learning
- ▶ Greater opportunity to return to key objectives to give learning depth
  
- ▶ **Mastery of the depth of learning will look like this:**
- ▶ **Acquiring knowledge through teaching that is centred around modelling and explaining**
- ▶ **Applying and practising learning through reminding and guiding**
- ▶ **Deepening and expanding learning through coaching, probing and questioning**

## Where do the milestones come from?

- ▶ The milestones meet all the standards of the new national curriculum - they will be met at a basic level and then working towards an advancing and then deep level
- ▶ We believe that learning takes time and some children take longer than others to achieve
- ▶ We want the focus for progress to be the depth of learning rather than the quantity

# How will school map out progress?

- ▶ There are common learning objectives for all year groups (READING: To read words accurately. To understand texts)
- ▶ Each learning objective has 3 milestones for progress
- ▶ Milestone 1 is the expectation for the end of Year Two (learning zones to explain how we will cater for the depth of learning through the milestone)
- ▶ There are no level descriptors in the new curriculum (1B, 2C etc.)
- ▶ We will still report progress to you over the year
- ▶ Family Learning Calendar 2014-2015

# How will children be organised?

- ▶ 4 learning zones: Starfish, Turtles, Seahorses & Oysters
- ▶ **SAME:**
- ▶ Timetable will remain the same (focus teaching, areas of continuous provision etc.)
- ▶ Topics will remain (Long Term Planning)
- ▶ Cloakrooms, entrances, toilets
- ▶ Key Stage One for 2 years
- ▶ **DIFFERENT**
- ▶ No Year 1 and Year 2 anymore
- ▶ Times of school day: 8:45am - 12 noon Lunch 1:05pm - 3:05pm
- ▶ Milestones
- ▶ Stages NOT ages
- ▶ New staff
- ▶ Tracking progress
