Dear Parents/Carers,

Following our 'Journey to improvement' launch I would like to tell you about the important changes we have made to our behaviour policy.

We have tightened our good systems so that all children are able to learn in our happy and safe environment.

These are our school rules:

- We will keep each other safe and happy
- We will respect our environment & whole school community
- We will be polite and do as we are asked first time

Children will be reminded of these rules at all times with pictures.

We will use our traffic light system

- It's good to be green-children are making the right choices
- Children will be reminded of the rules
- Children will enter amber if they need reminding a second time
- Children will move to red if they receive 2 more reminders

Children on red will:

- Receive reflection time during playtime in the school hall/lunchtime play red spot
- Parents will be notified on the day of red behaviour via telephone/text-they will need to speak to the teacher at the end of the school day/via telephone call
- 3 reds-parents will be invited into school to meet with the Headteacher/Behaviour team to discuss supportive ways forward

Children will move straight to red for:

- Unsafe behaviour/hurting others/verbal abuse others/destroying school resources
- Parent/s will be informed immediately via telephone and further actions will be discussed.

All red behaviour will be recorded.

All children will be supported and helped through the traffic light system.

Rewards

- Green behaviour will be celebrated daily with owl tokens towards bronze/silver/gold award
- Texts and Star postcards will be sent to parents recognising green behaviour
- Children in green all week will be recognised at weekly special mentions assembly
- Lunchtime weekly award for best class lining up-all class receive summertime treat

Nursery children

Butterflies will follow:

- The traffic light system-red behaviour=time out chair in Butterflies
- Owl stickers instead of tokens-will work towards bronze/silver/gold awards

Caterpillars will follow:

- The traffic light system and given lots of reminders
- Red behaviour=time out of an activity in Caterpillars
